> Howard- Below are the procedures which were discussed at our Group  
> Leaders' meeting as needing to be deleted. I have provided a very brief  
> description of the reason for deleting each procedure. By the  
> requirements of BDAP-01-0001, John Marriner should give his approval  
> prior to actually deleting any BDAP or BDSP procedure. -Raymond  
>  
> BDAP-04-0001, Non-Hazardous Recycling Program. Not required by any  
> standard; recycling program changes frequently with those changes  
> communicated to division personnel by Building Managers and others.  
>  
> BDSP-01-0402, Follow-Up on AD Internal ES&H Audits. The audits which  
> are the subject of this procedure were required under the old SAP  
> program, but have been replaced by the Tripartite Assessment scheme, so  
> procedure no longer applies.  
>  
> BDSP-05-0611, Beams Division Hearing Conservation Implementation  
> Procedure. The division follows the program requirements in Fermilab  
> ES&H Manual Chapter (FESHM) 5061 and a separate, division-specific  
> procedure is not required.  
>  
> BDSP-05-0631, Beams Division Confined Space Implementation Procedure.  
> The division follows the program requirements in FESHM 5063 and a  
> separate, division-specific procedure is not required. We should,  
> however, issue a policy statement regarding our use of the option in  
> FESHM 5063 to have an ES&H Dept. representative approve permit-required  
> entries.

> BDSP-05-0632, Switchyard F-2 and F-3 Manholes Confined Space Entry

- > Permit Procedure. Entries into these spaces are now handled the same as
- > all other confined space entries. No separate procedure is required.

- > BDSP-05-0651, Heat and Cold Stress Implementation Procedure. The
- > division follows the program requirements in FESHM 5065.1 and a
- > separate, division-specific procedure is not required.
- >
- > BDSP-05-1201, General Lockout-Tagout Procedure. The division follows
- > the program requirements in FESHM 5120 and a separate, division-specific
- > procedure is not required.

- > BDSP-06-0001, Fire Protection System Disablement Program. The division
- > follows the program requirements in FESHM 6030 and a separate,
- > division-specific procedure is not required.

- > BDSP-99-0002, Responsibilities. The subject material is addressed by
- > FESHM 1010; no division-specific procedure is required.
- >
- > BDSP-99-0004, Radiation Work Procedures. The subject material is
- > addressed by the Fermilab RadCon Manual (FRCM) and Radiation Work
- > Permits.

- > BDSP-99-0006, Radiography. The subject material is addressed by the
- > FRCM and a BD Radiation Safety Group procedure.
